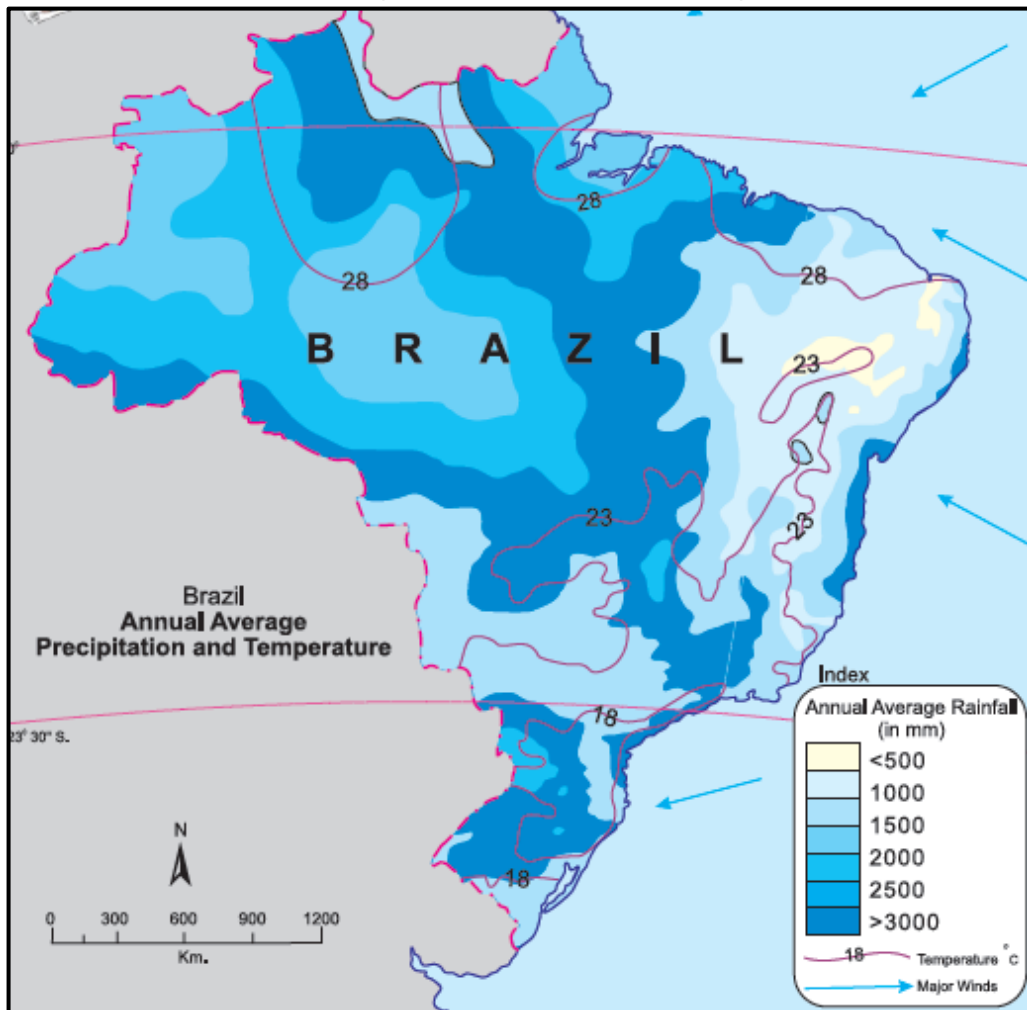

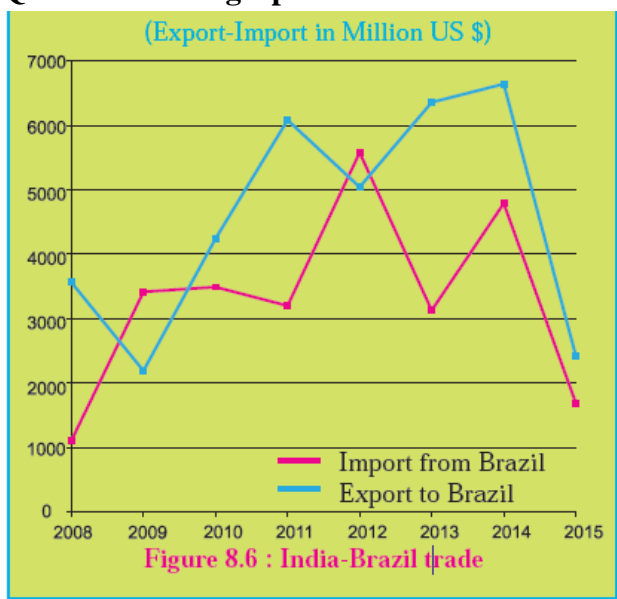
Contribution of Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Sectors to the National Incomes of India and Brazil.
